## OFFICIAL RULES – SUBMITTING AN ENTRY

**DEADLINE: MAY 2, 2022**

### Categories:

The following categories apply to Practitioners ONLY:

- **Best Reliability Engineering for Maintenance Program**
- **Best Asset Condition Management Program**
- **Best Work Execution Management Program**
- **Best Leadership for Reliability Program**
- **Best Asset Management Program**
- **Best Reliability Sustainability Program**
- **Best Digital Transformation for Reliability and Asset Management**
- **Special Recognition: Innovation Award (i.e., Use of Drones, Predictive Analytics and Internet of Things)**

### Entry form:

All entries must be submitted using the official electronic entry form. All information requested on the entry form must be provided. An incomplete form or a form providing misleading or false information will result in disqualification.

### Eligibility:

Entries must meet all of the following criteria:

- Must be a practitioner.
- An authorized representative of the practitioner's company must complete the entry form verifying all information.

No postal mailings will be accepted. Submitted photos and other materials will become the property of Uptime® Magazine and Reliabilityweb.com®.

### Entry fee:

There is no entry fee for Uptime Awards 2022.

### Limitation on entries:

Up to two categories may be selected for award entry per company.

### Important dates:

Entries must be completed and submitted by 11:59 pm EST on **May 2, 2022**.  
Winners will be notified by **June 3, 2022**.

## OFFICIAL RULES – SUBMITTING AN ENTRY

**DEADLINE: MAY 2, 2022**

### Essay and supporting materials:

Each entry form must include a 1,000 to 2,500-word essay about your program and your team. Include the following information:

- List your company mission, vision and values
- List team member certifications
- List ISO certifications
- List reliability and asset management software utilized
- List condition monitoring systems used
- List previous awards earned

### Additional supporting company or team material may include (optional):

- An illustration or photo (suitable for publication, color preferred) of the team and/or company (1000 x 600-pixel png or jpg)
- An illustration or photo (suitable for publication, color preferred) of your company's product, software, training or service (1000 x 600-pixel png or jpg)
- 100 to 200-word description of your company's product, software, training or service
- URL, PDF brochure or video link of your company

### Uptime Awards judging:

Voting will be performed by the Reliabilityweb.com judging panel. Their decisions are final.

### Awards:

The Uptime Awards will be presented to the best program in each category, as applicable. A brief description of each Uptime Award winner's program will be published on event website. The Uptime Awards Ceremony will be held at IMC-2022 at the JW Marriott Resort on Marco Island, Florida. This is a live, in-person event, so all winners are required to attend (1 representative is required; additional ones may attend).

### Disqualification:

Any entry that, in the opinion of the judges or administrators, does not meet the letter or spirit of this contest may be disqualified. The following specifically will be grounds for disqualification:

- Entries that do not comply with all of these official rules.
- Entries that are incomplete.
- Entries that contain false or misleading information.
- Entries submitted on behalf of anyone other than the company represented.
